The Museum Of Everything is on a roll of big-name collaborations. After revealing that hot label Clements Ribeiro has designed a collection in line with the upcoming Exhibition #4, it is moving on to footwear.

Artist Dan Miller, who is taking part in Exhibition #4, was chosen by Tracey Neuls Footwear to create a pair of limited-edition shoes. Neuls incorporated Miller's art into a beautiful and wearable design.

Like fellow artists on display at the MOE, Miller is self-taught and unknown. His haunting drawings consist of language in the form of dense, illegible words that serve as a record of his life and obsessions.

Exhibition #4 opens tomorrow at Selfridges, where it will occupy more than 15,000sq ft, making it the most expansive art collaboration in the store's history.

The MOE will curate the Ultralounge exhibition hall and

all the windows along Oxford Street and Orchard Street.
